All competitions will be held at Tropicana Field in St. Petersburg, Florida. Tropicana Field, a domed stadium, is the home of the Tampa Bay Rays professional baseball team and the site of the 1999 NCAA Men's Final Four Basketball Tournament.

The arena is large enough for seven women's meets, one men's meet and an All Star Cheerleading Competition to all be going on simultaneously. Spectators will sit throughout the 50,000 seat domed stadium with a great view and comfortable seating.
